- 12:00 Noon** POE "Holiday on the Bay" opens - Entertainment, food, beverages, crafts for children of all ages.
- 3:00 p.m.** Skipper's Meeting - North Marina, J Dock, Party Barge
Review weather and parade schedule. Sunset occurs at 4:18 PM.
- 4:00 p.m.** Parade boats rendezvous in the river north of Anthony's Restaurant and form a single line behind lead boat "About Time" captained by Past Commodore Bruce Fabert.
- Skippers please monitor Channel 09**
- 4:15 p.m.** *About Time* departs for Mukilteo with City of Everett Police Boat escort. Parade boats will cruise past the Mukilteo Lighthouse just after the 5:00 p.m. ferry leaves the dock. Boats circle in front of Lighthouse Park until Mukilteo lights their Christmas Tree.
- 5:20 p.m.** After east bound ferry arrives at the dock, parade boats head back (single file) to POE.
- 6:00-6:15 p.m.** Parade boats cruise to entrance of North Marina. Parade boats fall in line (single file) behind Past Commodore Don Hopkins in *Yeah! ... Santa's Sleigh Boat!* *Yeah!* will lead boats into the Marina to the new travel lift where Santa will disembark to light the POE Christmas Tree.

Parade boats may temporarily tie up on the travel lift dock, Bayside Marine dock or J (guest) dock.

Following the tree lighting and welcoming remarks, boats return to their respective slips.
