Public notice is hereby given that the Port of Everett seek Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from qualified firms, or multi-disciplinary teams of firms, to provide environmental consulting services for the East Waterway cleanup site (East Waterway).

The East Waterway Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) site is located in Everett, Washington within Port Gardner Bay. This site is considered part of Washington State's Puget Sound Initiative and is managed out of Department of Ecology (Ecology) headquarters. The Port is soliciting SOQs from interested firms who are capable of providing consulting services for both in-water and upland MTCA cleanup for this project in coordination with Port staff, other PLPs, legal counsel and Ecology managers.

The scope of the consulting services in contained the request for qualifications (RFQ). Briefly, the scope of services includes, but is not limited to, project management, remedial investigation, feasibility studies, remedial design, remediation cost estimating, complex project permitting, and stakeholder / public involvement. The final scope will be developed collaboratively with the Port and its legal team, once the consultant firm or team is selected.
