Port Commission Governance Structure Join the Discussion

The Port of Everett Commission is hosting two public meetings to solicit comments from Port District residents on whether the Port should modify its governance structure. The Port Commission will decide on June 8, 2010 what changes, if any, to place on the November 2010 ballot for voter consideration.

The following are the issues to be discussed. Should the Port Commission:

1. Maintain its current governance structure, which is:
 - a. Three commissioners, each with a defined commission district, serving six year terms
2. Establish a new governance structure by making any of the following changes:
 - a. Increasing the number of commissioners from three to five
 - b. If two new commissioners are added, should each represent a defined commission district, or should they both represent the Port district at-large
 - c. Reduce the terms from six years to four years
