POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Port is seeking to hire a Maintenance Journeyman to provide proper maintenance and repair of equipment, facilities and grounds located in and around the Port of Everett Marine Terminals and other Port-owned property. An apprenticeship may also be considered.

Skill areas may include some, but not necessarily all, of the following:

- Cranes/Heavy Equipment: Operate, troubleshoot and maintain cranes and heavy equipment. Must be able to regularly work at heights of 100 feet or more.
- Bulk Handling Operations: Operate, troubleshoot and maintain materials unloading systems, including repair and maintenance of unloader, bulk handling conveyors, car puller and load out systems. Provide service to mobile heavy equipment.
- Electrical: Maintain, troubleshoot and repair electrical services and systems related to cranes and bulk handling equipment, rolling stock & Port facilities, including but not limited to floats, docks, buildings, parking lots.
- Mechanical: Maintain, troubleshoot and repair mechanical systems, including rolling stock (gas, diesel, propane internal combustion engines), hydraulic and air systems, Port-owned cranes and bulk handling equipment.
- Welding: Perform welding tasks needed to maintain facilities.
- Equipment Operation: Drive Port vehicles and operate rolling stock and other equipment for maintenance purposes, including fork lifts, boom trucks, dump trucks, lift equipment, front end loaders, backhoes, compressors and generators, the Port tug or other boat to move or maneuver boats, logs, floats, etc.
- Plumbing: Maintain, troubleshoot and repair water systems, including potable water, fire and irrigation systems.

- Carpentry: Perform carpentry and woodworking tasks, including construction and repair of docks, wharves, floats and buildings and finish work such as hanging doors and basic cabinetwork.
- Landscaping: Perform landscape maintenance tasks, including planting, transplanting, pesticide and fungicide applications, pruning and fertilizing.

Preferred Work Experience:

- Must be able to successfully complete the Port's Apprentice Program, or possess an appropriate technical program certificate; and have three (3) years related work experience. An equivalent combination of training and experience may substitute.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- High school diploma or general education degree (GED).
- Ability to read and comprehend instructions, short correspondence and memos in English. Ability to effectively communicate with customers, clients and coworkers.
- Ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, fractions, and decimals.
- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed written or oral instructions. Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations.
- Valid driver's license, and insurability under the Port of Everett auto insurance plan.
- Ability to obtain and maintain a Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC).

Physical and Working Conditions:

- Incumbents must be physically able to perform each essential duty of the position satisfactorily. Work includes exposure to weather, heights that could exceed 100' and occasional contact with open water. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable qualified individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
