



Notice of Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance (MDNS)

Phase I - Marina Maintenance Dredging
Port SEPA File No. 2011-04

The Port of Everett has issued a mitigated determination of non-significance (MDNS) under the State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter WAC 197-11) for the following project:

Proponent and Lead Agency: Port of Everett, P O Box 538, Everett, Washington 98206.

Description of Proposed Action: The Port of Everett (Port) proposes to conduct maintenance dredging at its north and south marinas (Marina). Maintenance dredging is necessary to remove a portion of accumulated sediment material that has caused a shallower depth to occur than originally designed. This requires the Marina to be dredged to its original design depth of -12 Mean Lower Low Water (MLLW) with an allowed 2-foot overdredge (-14 MLLW). Marine sediment will be mechanically dredged. Dredging will remove approximately 30,000 cubic yards of material to be transported to the Port Gardner Puget Sound Dredge Disposal Area (PSDDA), located in Puget Sound. Dredging is expected to occur between December 2011 and February 15, 2012, which is within the in-water work window (typically July 15th – February 15th). Construction is expected to last approximately 45 days. The Shoreline Permit (SMA #5-99) issued by the City of Everett for dredge material disposal at the PSDDA site is valid through December 15, 2014.

Location: Port of Everett's Marina is located between the 1400 and 1700 blocks of West Marine View Drive, Everett, Washington 98201. Parcels affected are Snohomish County Tax Account Numbers 29051800208400, 29051800300900 and 29081800300800, located in the northwest and southwest quarter of Section 18, Township 29 North, Range 5 East, W.M.

After review of a completed checklist and other information on file with the agency, the Port of Everett has determined that this proposal will not have a probable adverse impact on the environment.
