



Instructions for Pick-Up and Delivery of Breakbulk Cargo Port of Everett Marine Terminals

Information required to pick up/deliver cargo:

- Vessel Name and Voyage Number
- Ocean Bill of Lading Number (import) or Booking Number (export)
- Case numbers and identifying marks with number of items to be picked up
- Delivery Order or Trucker Short Bill Lading

Driving Directions to the Port of Everett Marine Terminals:

From I-5 Northbound (from Seattle): Take Exit 195 - East Marine View Drive. Follow the signs to the Port of Everett. East Marine View Drive becomes West Marine View Drive. Follow West Marine View Drive along the waterfront heading south about 1.5 miles to Terminal Avenue. Turn right on Terminal Avenue, going over the bridge 1 block to the truck lanes. The guard will direct you to the terminal (this route takes you on the perimeter of town)

From I-5 Southbound: Take Exit 194 - Everett Avenue. Stay right. Turn right at stop sign onto Everett Avenue. Continue west on Everett Avenue all the way across town and down the hill. Everett Avenue ends with the intersection at West Marine View Drive. Continue straight through the intersection onto the bridge, which will continue to Terminal Avenue. Go 1 block to the truck lanes. The guard will direct you to the terminal.

From US2 Westbound: Stay right when approaching the I-5 interchange. Take the first right after the I-5 overpass on Walnut. Stay left, and turn left at the light onto Everett Avenue. Continue west on Everett Avenue all the way across town and down the hill. Everett Avenue ends with the intersection at West Marine View Drive. Continue straight through the intersection onto the bridge, which will continue to Terminal Avenue. Go 1 block to the truck lanes. The guard will direct you to the terminal.
