Public notice is hereby given that the Port of Everett has issued a Request for Bids for the above-named project, with sealed bids due no later than the date and time given above.

The Port of Everett seeks a Contractor to move the historic Weyerhaeuser Building, as part of the Waterfront Place Central redevelopment, out to Boxcar Park. Built in 1923, the Weyerhaeuser Building is on the National Register of Historic Places and will serve as a public focal point along the redevelopment's North Esplanade District.

This project will 1) see the Weyerhaeuser Building move to its new location at Boxcar Park, with foundation establishment; 2) re-stabilize the building's current pad for future development; 3) provide move route modifications to utilities, landscaping and structures; 4) demolish current existing steel storage building prior to Weyerhaeuser Building move; 5) move mobile restroom facility to demolished storage building pad; and 6) perform pertinent site repairs/improvements from the project impact.

Due to the importance of all Bidders having a clear understanding of the specifications and scope of work requirements for this project, two pre-bid meetings have been scheduled. Bidders need not attend both of the meetings, but attendance to at least one is **MANDATORY**. Subcontractors are highly encouraged to attend, but are not required. Attendance at the pre-bid meeting will be evidenced by the bidder's representative's signature on the attendance roster. No bidder will be admitted more than ten (10) minutes after the official start of the pre-bid meetings. Attendance to at least one of the pre-bid meetings is a pre-requisite for submitting a bid. The Port reserves the right to schedule additional pre-bid meetings if the Port determines it is in its best interest.
