

APPENDIX C: PRIOR GRANTS AND LOANS RECEIVED BY THE PORT OF EVERETT

Some of the previous grant and loan funding received by the Port of Everett include:

- 2007 – Federal Port Security Grant of \$1.073 million to construct a rail access recovery line;
- 2009 – Federal Port Security Grant of \$1.502 million to enhance lighting in the South Terminal;
- 2010 – Federal FHWA Direct Appropriation of \$1.169 million to aid in the construction of the rail access recovery line, partially funded by the 2007 Port Security Grant mentioned above;
- 2010 – Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) Rail Bank Loan of \$1.2 million to complete the funding for the rail access recovery line;
- 2013 – WSDOT Rail Bank Loan of \$900,000 to fund the rehabilitation of an existing rail spur and construction of a through track off the main line.
- 2013 – Washington Department of Commerce grant of \$1.5 million to help fund the strengthening of a small portion of the South Terminal wharf to enable Roll-on/Roll-off ships to utilize the berth;
- 2014 – WSDOT Rail Bank Loan of \$911,715 to assist in the funding of the wharf strengthening mentioned above;
- 2015 – Washington Department of Commerce grant of \$1 million to assist in the funding of the double rail siding element of this project
